THE PROBLEM

Heat failure remains one of the highest risk conditions for hospital readmissions, especially within the first 30 days. Many patients return simply because they lack support managing weight, diet, and medications at home.

 Up to 60% of readmissions are preventable with better post-discharge support. *(Journal of Cardiac Failure, 2023)*



WHY IT MATTERS

Hospitals, rehab teams, and case managers are navigating strict readmission penalties. When a CHF patient goes home without oversight, fluid retention, medication errors, and missed follow-ups drive unnecessary returns.
